RE: **Seasonal Track Laborer**

These are seasonal, general labor positions. Principal duties are the safe and efficient completion of maintenance and construction projects across the Montana Rail Link system. These are entry level positions and the successful candidates will be monitored for adherence to safety rules and railroad regulations. These positions may be subject to random drug testing per the Federal Railroad Administration drug testing regulations.

Work locations are varied and applicants must be willing to accept assignments at any MRL location. Job placement will be assigned according to seniority. These are generally section positions for which no per diem is provided. Pay class is \$15.77/hr. per the Union Agreement.

Requirements:

- Commitment to working safely with the ability and desire to observe and promote safe work habits. High personal expectations that will contribute to achievement of safety goals
- Must exemplify MRL core values of Fairness, Integrity, Respect, Safety and Trust
- Must be 18 years of age or older
- High school diploma or GED required
- Must possess a valid driver's license
- Possess a CDL or have the ability to obtain one within first 90 days of employment
- Ability to lift up to 100 lbs. using proper lifting techniques
